CRAIGLOCKHART CAMPUS

ICONIC DESIGN



Our spectacular Craiglockhart Campus is a modern, spacious venue with an iconic design.

It has two state-of-the-art lecture theatres both with tiered seating and built-in audio-visual equipment and 20 flexible seminar rooms.

The Dr Stephen Riady Lecture Theatre is the largest, with seating for 400 delegate and the most up-to-date AV equipment suitable for hybrid meetings and conferences. The 200-seater landmark Lindsay Stewart Lecture Theatre is a unique talking point with delegates due to its unusual shape and design.

The campus has a diverse range of flexible options including plenty of computing facilities.

Merchiston Campus is the closest of Edinburgh Napier University's venues to the city centre, with good public transport links to and from the city.

Merchiston Campus is built around the refurbished shell of Merchiston Castle (Tower) which was built circa. 1454.

The castle is most notable for being the home of John Napier, the University's namesake, remembered for making one of the most important contributions to the advance of knowledge through the design of mathematical logarithms and the decimal point.

In 1833, the Tower was let to the Merchiston Castle School. After the school moved premises in the 1930s, the building underwent restoration work and now stands at the centre of Merchiston Campus.

Merchiston has ample classroom facilities, and a modern tiered 120 seated lecture theatre ideal for a stand alone lecture or plenary session. The catering area at Merchiston is a bright modern facility that can seat 200 delegates in one sitting. This campus is most suited for hire during evening, weekend and vacation periods.

For networking events, you can take advantage of our brand new drinks reception facility, The Glass Room, with space for up to 55 guests

It has three modern lecture theatres with the largest holding 400 delegates.

Our exclusive events space - the Horizon Suite -on the 5th floor of our Sighthill campus has floor to ceiling windows and offers a panoramic view over the city that is sure to wow guests.

With excellent transport links to the city, airport and motorway network, Sighthill is ideal for smaller meetings and larger conferences alike.

GETTING TO EDINBURGH

> BY AIR

Edinburgh Airport is only 15 minutes away from the city centre. Airlink Buses and trams from outside the arrivals area are frequent and run approx. every 10 minutes. A taxi will take approx. 15 minutes to our campuses.

BY TRAIN

There are regular train services from all main UK routes to both Edinburgh Waverley and Haymarket Stations.

▶ BY CAR

As Edinburgh is located at the heart of the Scottish motorway network, it is surprisingly quick and easy to get to by car. Edinburgh is only 3 hours away from Inverness and just over 2 hours from Aberdeen.

Journey times from England are just as good with approximately a 5 hour drive from Birmingham, 4 hours from Manchester and just 2 hours from Newcastle.
