- Research















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The Good...


"I tend to generally find change difficult, but my results have held up since college and surpassed my expectations."

The bad...



Pitfalls to avoid


- Be aware of timing and rhythm of engagement
- Lack of engagement by those who most need it
- Facebook overwhelm in posts turned people off





Best practice advice

- Students required tailored support before, during and after transition
- VLEs and Social Media contribute significantly to social cohesion
- No context specific differences
