## Sport Science

Sport and Exercise Sciences students spend much of their time developing their knowledge in our biomechanics and human performance labs. We have the largest environmental chamber in Scotland, so you can send someone to Everest Base Camp or the Amazon rainforest without even leaving the room. In 2016 we opened our new £2.9million sports centre, expanding our weights training facilities and adding a 20m

running track and studios. Our partnership with the BT Sport Scottish Rugby Academy enables us to play a key role in the development of Scotland's future sporting talent and you get to attend lectures given by sporting professionals at the peak of their game. We also have a healthy range of sports teams and societies, which play at local and national level.

All of our undergraduate biology courses have been accredited by the Royal Society of Biology, meaning you can impress to employers that you will graduate with industry-level skills that have been verified by your subject's professional body.

## Social Sciences

We are a Top 10 modern UK University for Criminology and Sociology (Guardian University Guide 2018). Students have access to purpose built labs and data analysis software, enabling them to conduct research and other practical work. In addition to specialist labs for perception, eye tracking, observation of social interaction, we also have numerous experimental interview rooms supported by state of the art video cameras and editing facilities. Our Psychology courses are also accredited by the British Psychological Society. The Criminology course provides our graduates with a range of key skills

relating to employability. At the same time, the focus on crime allows for specialisation in the important areas of crime and justice. Our new Policing & Criminology course is designed for those wishing to enter policing or work in the criminal justice system.
